Course Delivery Methods.

This is a full-time course of 14 weeks duration. It offers you the opportunity to learn and develop the knowledge and skills to produce digital photographic images. The emphasis is on hands-on practical training. While you will learn the theoretical elements of digital photography in a classroom environment, the majority of your time will be spent developing practical skills while undertaking a range of projects. You will be required to actively participate in the learning process and engage in course work outside of normal course hours. Course work includes written and practical assignments, project work and a learner diary. Assessment for certification purposes is by way of project work, a formal portfolio of your work and a self-reflective record of your learning experiences, activities and learning outcomes.

- Reached the statutory school leaving age.
- Possess a reasonable level of computer skills.
- Have a genuine interest in photography.
- Possess good communication skills.
- Have the ability to work effectively within a team.
